1. Welcome & Apologies for absence, Steve Cross

2. Minutes of last Meeting. Were approved by Sherrie.

3. Budget/Financial Helen stated that we were still on target. VAT figures should be in next week. BID has paid $\frac{3}{4}$ of the New year's fireworks bill already. It was agreed by the board that we should pay 50 % of Dom's for the Christmas lights. It was suggested that we have the mobile numbers of Dom's team as they will not be putting up the Christmas Ball lights until the 28th November.

Helen to ask Dom when the big tree was going to be put up.

4. New Town Fund. Next public meeting will be at Kidz'R'Us 14/11/19 2pm.

5. St. Ives in December. Belinda informed the board that everything is booked and ready for the event.

6. New Year's Eve. Alex has been in talks with the Town Council about a contribution toward the celebrations. They have agreed to contribute £3000.

Helen has spoken to the plastic free group; they will arrange litter pickers for the night. Helen and Belinda have also spoken to the breweries that supply the pubs in the town and asked what they will be doing about plastic free for New years eve. Most people were doing nothing, Helen

contacted a number of suppliers and will be sending links to businesses to encourage them to purchase multi use rather than single use glasses/mugs.

7. Rubbish Helen has been in talks with the council about the business rubbish bins. The council will be sending out code of conduct contracts to the problem hot spots around the town.

8. Cigarette Bins. It was noted that the bins were over flowing. Justin said that he empty's them when he can. He will monitor them over the next few weeks.

9. Climate Change Justin has agreed to join the Climate Change as a BID representative.

10. CCTV. Helen has spoken to St.Ives Holidays has agreed to have the CCTV attached to their building. Helen to talk to Town Council about funding for extra cover on the CCTV over the New Years eve.

11. Shop Watch. Helen has been in contact with Truro shop watch, there has been a problem over Data protection. It has been suggested that all shop watch members have a written code of conduct to sign.

12. Tour of Britain Helen informed the group that the tour of Britain will be going through St.Ives September 2020. Their colours will be Black and White. It was suggested that we have Black and White bunting put up in the town.

13. Flower Boxes. The Town Council have asked if BID if they would take over the up keep and planting of the flower boxes on the Front. It was agreed that we would if the Town Council would contribute £1500. Helen to contact Councilor Tamsin Williams.

14. St.Ia Well The Town Council has agreed to pay the BID back the £120 that was paid to tidy up the St.Ia Well.

15. Crowd Funding It was agreed that Nick and James would look into crowd funding to help with the New Year's Eve fire work.

16. It was agreed that South West Water would attend the next meeting with the BID directors and Tregenna Castle directors to explain what they plan to do with the road works after the Christmas period.
