




St Ives Shanty Shout



NYE Fireworks

St Ives to ring in New Year with biggest firework display yet

The annual St Ives New Year's Eve firework display will be bigger and better than ever thanks to generous contributions from local businesses in the town.



Last year's celebrations saw nearly 30,000 people pour into the seaside town for the lavish show, thought to be the biggest turnout since the Millennium, with fireworks set off to commemorate the arrival of New Year in the biggest firework display the town had ever seen.



This year, more than two and a half tonnes of fireworks are due to be released, meaning that the display will rival the displays taking place in some of the major cities in the UK.

Award-winning firework provider and local Cornish company, Celebration Pyrotechnics, will once again be supplying the fireworks for the event and delivering the show.

A laser countdown clock will also be on display on the night to count down the hours, and the minutes, to midnight and the spectacular display. The firework display will start at midnight over the St Ives harbour front.





We are just waiting on permission from Cornwall Council Car Parks team for one location and can then, hopefully start installing the new signs. Installation is expected to take 4-8 weeks. Keep up-to-date on this project and view current proposed locations <u>here</u>.



The logo will be the most visible element of the St Ives brand. Its usage must be clear and consistent at all times.


Space




