After a recent meeting we have leant that Cornwall Council are installing new bins around St Ives for a trail that will run for 12 months. This trial did not include recycle bins so the BID Board voted to pay for six of these, also on a 12-month trial basis.

BID 2 will now take on more of a Chamber of Commerce roll. Part of this will be ensuring all new businesses get a "Welcome Pack" which will include what the BID does, useful numbers and course opportunities.
